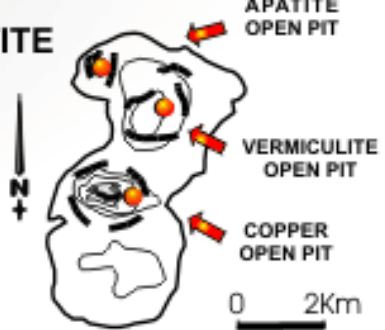

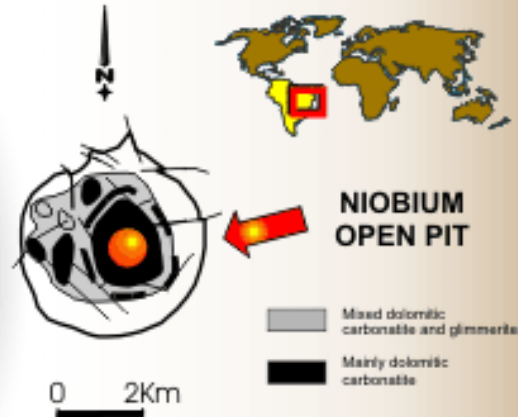
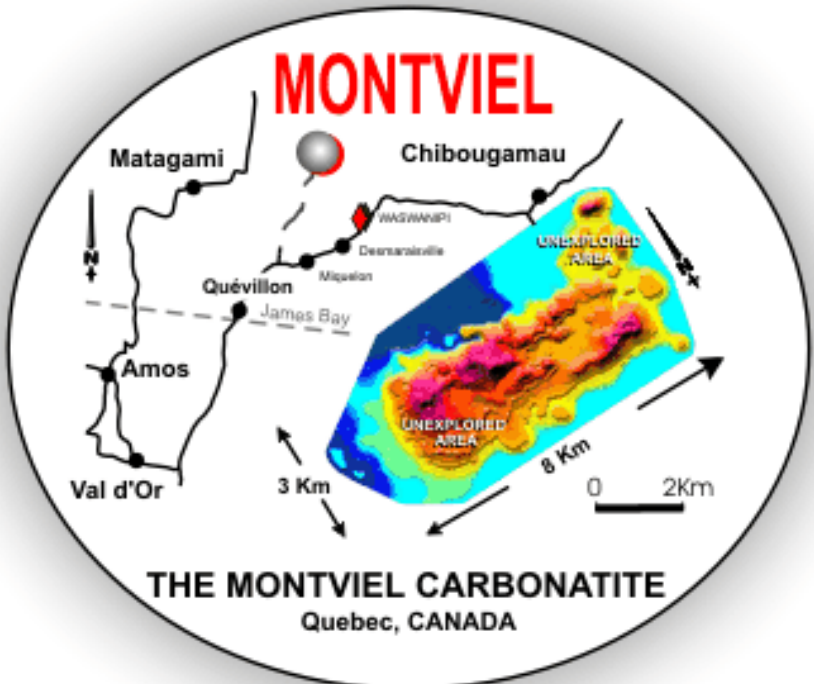
Proven and probable mineral reserves currently total 22 million tonnes at an average grade of 0.67% Nb<sub>2</sub>O<sub>5</sub>.

Reserves are about 460 million tons, with a grade between 2.5 and 3.0% Nb<sub>2</sub>O<sub>5</sub>, and is up to 250 m thick.

**SOME INTERESTING SIMILARITIES**

The Montviel Carbonatite by its size and from the little geological information available compares favourably with other world class carbonatites, for niobium, rare earths and phosphate resources.....Very little exploration carried out so far and this work was restricted to a number of shallow diamond drill holes on the central portion of the intrusion.....a sulphide halo was found on the periphery but remains largely untested.....
